PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION TO FIRST YEAR OF DEGREE COURSES IN AYURVEDA AND HOMOEOPATHY FOR THE SESSION 2012-2013

Admission to B.H.M.S. (Bachelor in Homoeopathic Medicine & Surgery) and B.A.M.S. (Bachelor in Ayurvedic Medicines and Surgery) courses in the following Homoeopathic and Ayurvedic Medical Colleges of Odisha will be made during the session 2012-2013.

Duration of Course : 5 & ½ years including one year compulsory rotatory internship.

2. **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION :**

2.1 **Qualification** : Candidate must have passed 10 + 2 Science or any other equivalent examination subject to production of proof of equivalency from competent authority with Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

2.2. **Nativity** :

Candidate applying for admission must belong to any of the following categories and furnish relevant certificate to that effect :

2.2.1 Permanent resident of Odisha (as defined in Govt. of Odisha, Home Department Resolution No. 38 (Reforms), dated 18th January, 1949) and prosecuting their studies in Odisha shall furnish Resident certificate from the concerned Tahasildar, obtained within a period of 6 (six) months.

2.2.2 Candidates claiming residence in Odisha but prosecuting studies in other States shall furnish Nativity Certificates from the **Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahasildar** of their native places. Such candidates must have Oriya as M.I.L. in 7th Pass or equivalent examination and shall submit certificate from competent authority.

2.2.3 Oriyas belonging to outlying Oriya speaking tracts (as defined by Govt. of Odisha in erstwhile P & S Department Resolution No. 13411/Gen. Dated 8th August, 1969). Such candidates must have Oriya as M.I.L. in 7th Pass or equivalent examination and furnish the certificates of authenticity of their Oriya origin from an officer not below the rank of Collector and a certificate of having passed Oriya as M.I.L. in 7th pass or equivalent examination from the competent authority.

2.2.4 Sons, daughters and spouses of permanent employees of Govt. of Odisha/ Members of All India Services (Odisha cadre) serving within or outside Odisha at the time of application / permanent employees of Govt. of India serving in Odisha at the time of application/ Permanent employees of Govt. of India/ Govt. of Odisha Undertakings & located in Odisha and serving in Odisha at the time of application, who have passed +2 Science or equivalent examination from any institution located within Odisha/ Permanent employees of Universities of Odisha/ Defence personnel posted in Odisha are eligible for admission (Such claim should be supported by certificate of service of parent or spouse from the competent authority).

2.3 **Certificate of Reserve category** :

2.3.1. Candidate claiming admission under Schedule Caste / Schedule Tribe shall furnish Caste Certificate from the Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahasildar.

2.3.2. Candidate claiming admission under Green Card category shall furnish Green Card from competent Medical authority.

- 2.3.3. Candidate claiming admission under Military / Ex. Service Man category shall furnish Certificate from competent authority.
- 2.3.4. Candidate claiming admission under P.H. category shall furnish Certificate from competent authority.
- 2.4. **Qualifying Marks** : Minimum 50% and 40% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together for general candidates and S.C./ S.T. candidates respectively.
- 2.5. **Age** : Candidate must be within the age group of 17 years to 25 years of age as on 31st December, 2012. Upper age limit is relaxed by 3 years for S.C. / S.T. candidates only. The candidates shall submit H.S.C. or equivalent certificate in support of age.

3. **SEATS AND RESERVATIONS** : The reservation of seats shall be as indicated below.

- 3.1.1. 22.50% for Scheduled Tribe candidates
- 3.1.2. 16.25% for Scheduled Caste candidates
- 3.1.3. 05% for Children of Green Card holders within concerned category.
- 3.1.4. 03% for Children of Military / Ex-service men within concerned category.
- 3.1.5. 03% for Physically handicapped candidates (as per C.C.I.M. guideline) within concerned category. Physically handicapped shall mean the person having Locomotory disability of lower limb only. Visually handicapped and hearing disabled shall not be illegible. Further the locomotory disabled involving the lower limb is permissible to the following extent.
- (i) If it involves only one lower limb it should have a minimum of 40% and should not exceed 60%.
- (ii) If it involves both the lower limbs the total disability should not exceed 60% with a minimum of 40%. The disability Certificate should be produced by a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board.
- 3.1.6. One seat each in Gopabandhu Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya, Puri (for B.A.M.S. Course) and Dr. Abhin Chandra Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Bhubaneswar (for B.H.M.S. Course) shall be kept reserved for the nominees of Government of India. If no candidate report for admission by the counseling date, the seat will be filled up by the General candidate from the merit list.
- 3.2. In private Ayurvedic and Homoeopathic Colleges the upper limit of management quota seat is 25% of the intake capacity of respective college.
- 3.3. Candidates belonging to reserved categories can also compete with general category candidates. A reserved category candidate figuring in the merit list for both reserved and general category may first exercise his / her option under reserved category. Candidate who foregoes option under reserved category may opt according to his / her merit position under general category for admission at the time of counselling.

3.4. Unfilled seats reserved for S.T. or S.C. category shall be filled up by admission of either S.C. or S.T. student respectively as the case may be. Reserved seats if unfilled will be diverted to general category.

4. **MODE OF SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION :**

Application in the prescribed form complete in all respects and accompanied with required documents should be made separately to the Principal, Gopabandhu Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya, Puri (Convenor, B.A.M.S. Selection Committee) for admission to B.A.M.S. course and **to the Principal-cum-Superintendent, Dr. Abhin Chandra Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Bhubaneswar (Convenor, B.H.M.S. Selection Committee) for admission to B.H.M.S. Course** for the session **2012-2013** by Regd. Post/ Speed Post / **Courier** so as to reach the respective authority on or before the last date stipulated in the advertisement. Envelop containing Application form shall be superscribed with capital letter "ADMISSION TO B.A.M.S. / ADMISSION TO B.H.M.S. COURSE" whichever is applicable, on the basis of application being submitted for Ayurveda or Homoeopathy respectively. Photocopies of the relevant documents with full signature of the candidate should be attached to the Application form before sending. **Applications incomplete in any respect or without required documents or received after due date shall be rejected.** Delay by postal or courier service will not be considered even if the application form is despatched much earlier.

6. **DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION :**

- 6.6 Certificate claiming Reserved Category.
- 6.7 College leaving certificate or equivalent certificate.

7. **SELECTION :**

Provisional selection for admission shall be made strictly **on the basis of merit** i.e. according to the marks obtained in the subject Physics, Chemistry and Biology of the qualifying examination. In case of tie, the inter-se-merit shall be determined as per the decision of the Selection Committee.

8. **COUNSELLING FOR ADMISSION :**

Candidates provisionally selected shall be intimated by the respective Convenors to attend the counselling on a fixed date and time. The seats in different colleges shall be allotted on the basis of merit and preference expressed through counselling. Failure to turn up for counselling and to take admission by the stipulated time shall render the candidate to forfeit his/ her claim for the seat and the chance shall be given to the next candidate in the merit list.

9. **ADMISSION TO COLLEGES :**

- 9.1 Admissions to Ayurvedic or Homoeopathic Medical colleges for the session **2012-2013** are subject to their affiliation with the concerned University, concurrence of the State Government and permission of respective Central Council / Govt. of India.
- 9.2 Selected candidates shall be allotted seats in different Colleges through counselling and shall take admission after verification of all original documents including C.L.C./ S.L.C. and found fit for medical studies on examination by the Medical Board to be constituted by the respective Convenors on payment of prescribed fees.
- 9.3 Admission in Private Homoeopathy / Ayurvedic Medical Colleges in the State are subject to renewal of their recognition from the State Government before each admission session.

10. **FEES** :

11. **ATTENDANCE** :

11.1 **A student has to secure minimum 75% of attendance in both theory and practical in each subject of the course of study in order to make himself/ herself eligible to appear at the University examination.**

11.2 A student continuously remaining absent from classes for a period of more than six months without valid medical ground shall forfeit his/ her claim to be a student of the concerned college and his/ her name shall be struck off from the College Roll. However, to justify medical ground the student concerned shall produce Medical Certificate from a Specialist countersigned by the concerned C.D.M.O./ Professor of Medical Colleges.

12. Admission cannot be claimed as a matter of right. Final decision in the matter of admission rests with the Selection Committee and cannot be questioned in any forum.
